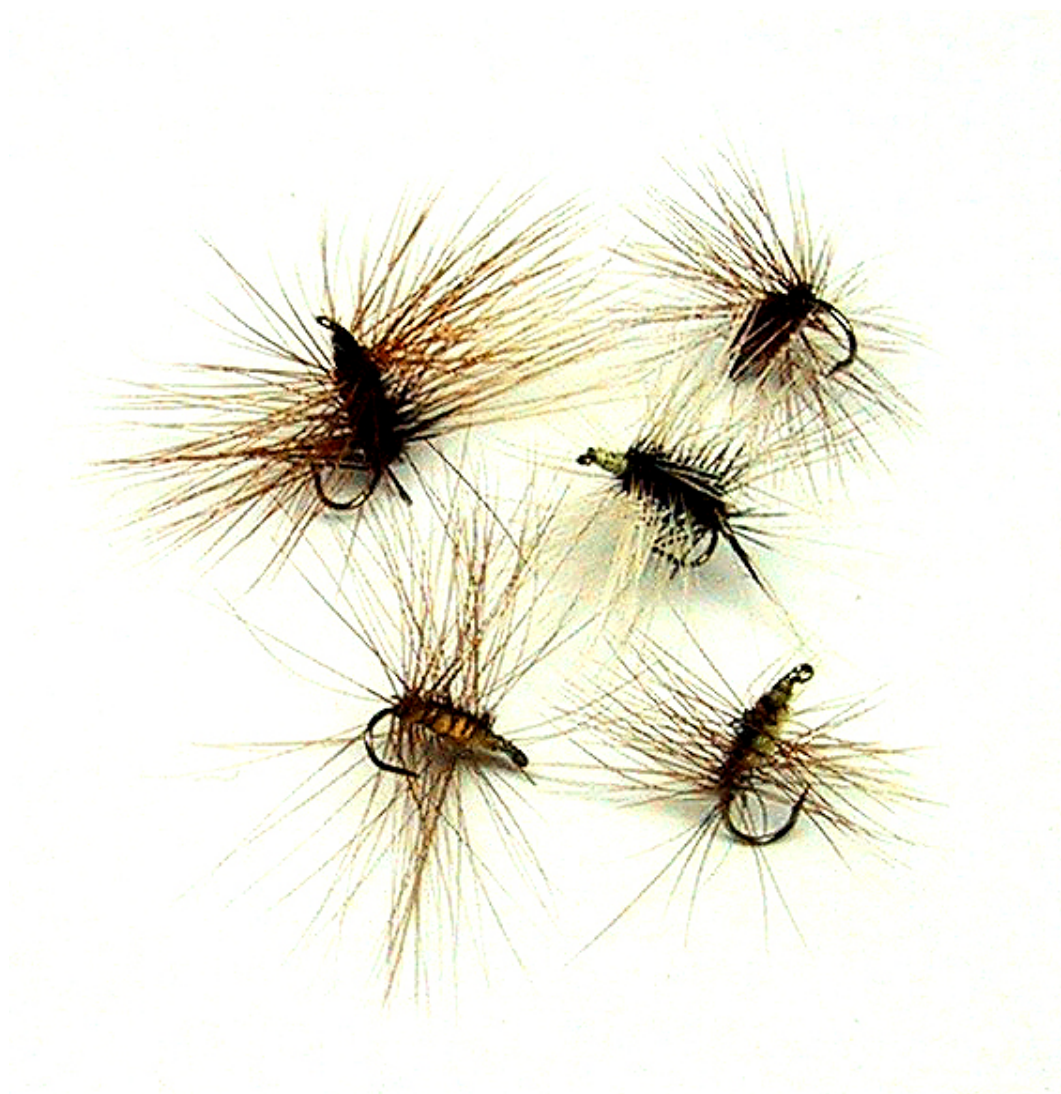


## Crackleback By David Chin Page 1



Crackleback tying size 12 and 14.

### Material:

Hook: Standard dry fly hook.

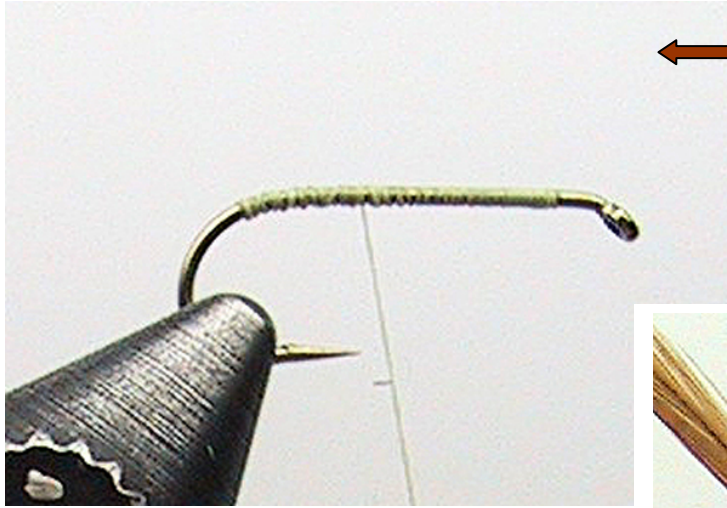
Body: Super fine brown and Yellow

Back: Peacock herls

Thread: color to match 8/0

Hackle: Furnace hackle

## Crackleback By David Chin Page 2

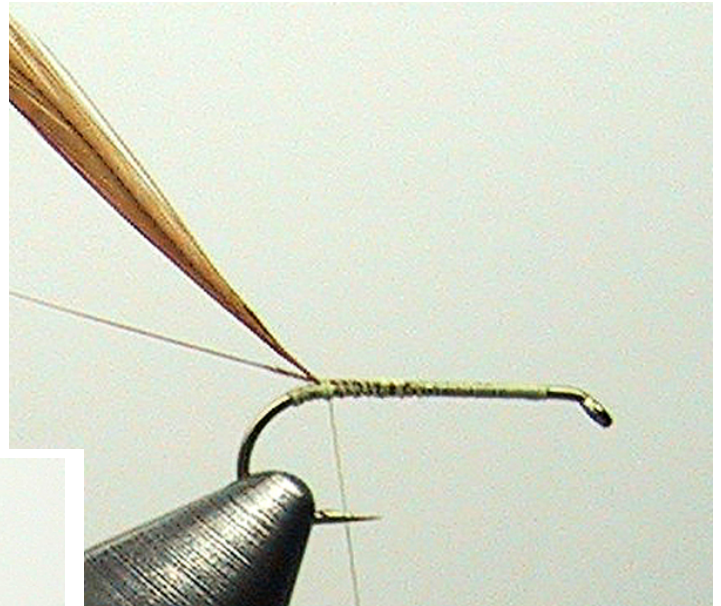


### Thread base. 2.1

Cover hook shank with thread and stop at 1/3 from bend of hook.

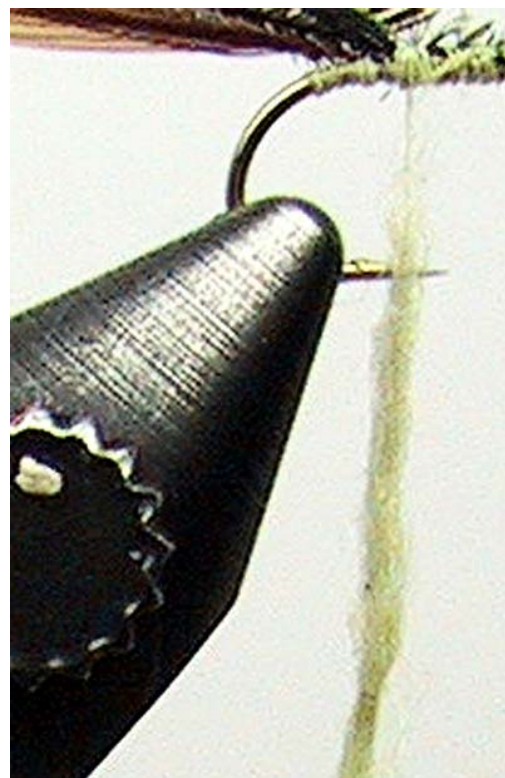
### → Tying in hackle. 2.2

Select a hackle. Use the 2 to 3 inches feathers from the tip to get the short fibers. Tie in and wind back to the bend of the hook.



### ← Tying in peacock herls. 2.3

Tie in 3 peacock herls at mid point of the the hook and wrap to the hackle tie in.



### → Dubbing the thread. 2.4

Dub the thread with super fine dry fly Dubbing. Yellow for this tie.

### Wrapping the Body. 3.1

Wrap the body with the dubbing thread.



### The Herl back 3.2

Pull the herls forward over the body. Tie off with thread and trim the herls.



### Wrapping the hackle. 3.4

Palmer the hackle forward and tie off at the front.
